

Submission Guidelines

Thomas Eads Fine Art is a retail gallery that features original painting, photography, and sculpture in styles from realism to abstraction. Artwork is accepted on a consignment basis only. The emphasis is on living U.S. Southeastern artists, and their interpretation of U.S. Southeastern culture.

Artists who are candidates for contracted representation by TEFA show strong evidence of recognition and accomplishment. In particular, this includes strong recent sales in the region, and a large, coherent body of recent work.

To submit slides or a CD, please send or bring:

1. Résumé including contact information, education, exhibitions, awards, publications, and service.
2. At least 10 slides, labeled with title, medium, and dimensions, of recent, available works, in a slide protector sheet;
3. Or at least 10 digital images on a CD with a list including filename, title, medium, and dimensions. For digital images, each should be no greater than 600 pixels in the longest dimension; 24-bit color (RGB 8-bits/channel), color space sRGB or Adobe RGB 1998 (ICC profile should be attached to the file), and preferred file format is TIFF or high quality (low compression) JPEG. Do not send images that were edited using an uncalibrated monitor, (color in such images will not be true). Label your CD with a copyright notice, your name, telephone number, and email address.
4. Self-addressed envelope for return of slides or CD, with sufficient postage affixed.

5. If you attach any kind of document or images to your email message, it will not be read at all.

Reviews are conducted approximately every two weeks. After the director reviews your materials, he will either respond by email indicating no interest at that time, or he will contact you with further instructions. Call only if four weeks have passed and the director has not responded to your submission. Thank you!
